Ms Cohn-Lois has been actively engaged in activities evolving around Women Empowerment since 2010, when she first initiated "I am Woman" ("Yo Soy Mujer" in Spanish)-initiative that seeks to address violence against women in the Dominican Republic and Haiti by empowering women emotionally and economically.

After having presented her idea at the Annual Meeting of the Clinton Global Initiative for Universities (CGI-U) in the University of California, San Diego, in 2011, her project was chosen to be showcased at the CGIU 2011 at Georgetown University due to the progress shown and the high social impact delivered in a small scale of time.

In 2012, Anniete became the 1st Dominican woman to run the largest university-student simulation of the United Nations in Europe: London International Model United Nations (LIMUN 2013), where she succeeded in presiding the conference through a gender perspective by establishing a simulation of UN Women for the 1st time in the history of the conference, guest speakers on violence against women, most specifically regarding honour crimes, 1,500 participants from more than 40 countries, high level members of the Diplomatic community and key note speaker: Ms Anne-Marie Leroy, Senior Vice President and World Bank Group General Counsel.

Anniete is a Dominican national. She holds a Bachelor of Arts in International Relations (BAIR) and is currently doing a Masters in Social Entrepreneurship (MSE) at Hult International Business School, London. She speaks English, Spanish and Medium-level French.
