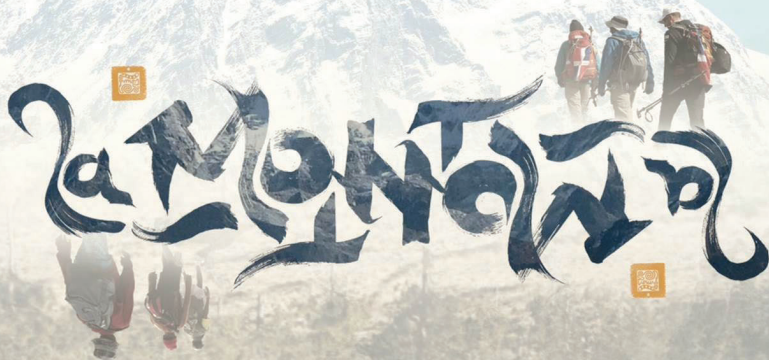


# Dominican Film SHOWCASE
